AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING TRANFER OF FUNDS FROM EPA RESTRICTED ACCOUNT TO WASTEWATER CAPTIAL IMPROVEMENTS ACCOUNT

WHEREAS, on April 6, 2026, the Board of Alderman of the City of Houston, Missouri, unanimously approved the purchase of a UV lamp and ballasts at the wastewater treatment plant from TROJAN Technologies, in the amount of \$14,726.77; and

WHEREAS, on April 20, 2026, the City of Houston, Missouri, paid TROJAN Technologies \$14,726.77 for the UV lamps and ballasts at the wastewater treatment plant; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing expenditures are eligible for payment using funds from the City's EPA Restricted Account; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Houston, Missouri, wishes to transfer funds from the City's EPA Restricted Account to the City's Wastewater Capital Improvements Account for the foregoing expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF HOUSTON, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. The City of Houston, Missouri, hereby authorizes the transfer of \$14,726.77 from the City's EPA Restricted Account to the City's Wastewater Capital Improvements Account.

Section Two. The City Clerk of the City of Houston, Missouri, on behalf of the City of Houston, Missouri, is hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$14,726.77 from the City's EPA Restricted Account to the City's Wastewater Capital Improvements Account.

Section Three. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after passage and approval as required by law.
